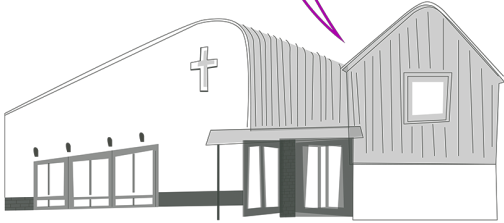

VOTING INFORMATION

Voting will take place on Thursday 17th January 2019 between 6pm and 8.30pm following which the votes will be counted. You can come along to vote at any time during that period.

The wording for the vote will be:

"I agree with the leaders and vestry that Westhill Community Church should leave the Scottish Episcopal Church"

To which you vote 'YES' or 'NO'

One voting form will be given to each person over 16 years of age whose details are in our church membership database.

If your details are not found in the database you can register them on the night by completing a data form and getting it signed by a member of either the leadership team or vestry to verify you are a member of Westhill Community Church.

For anyone unable to attend on the 17th you may authorise someone to vote on your behalf by giving them a signed letter clearly stating their name and yours (template attached - see top of email). The criteria for this would be that you are either overseas or away from the area on 17th January, hospitalised or for other reasons of illness or disability are unable to attend. Everyone else will be required to attend to vote.

Everyone who considers Westhill Community Church to be their home church should take the time to come and vote. It is an important event in the life of this church and should be treated accordingly.

Should you require transport to the church please make arrangements through your house group for lifts. If you are not in a house group and require a lift please notify the office by 2pm on Wednesday 16th January at the latest. We will try to arrange lifts for you.

The time for voting has been set to accommodate those with children, who can attend early bringing children with them, and later for those working.

Provided your details are in our database voting will only take a few minutes.

Throughout the voting period the sanctuary will be open for a time of prayer. Everyone welcome.
